HOW DOES A CIRCUMCISION AFFECT INTERCOURSE?

I. The sensitivity of circumcised sex

- **Short term:** During the healing period, the penis is more sensitive because of the lack of dermal protection.
- The skin of the glans gets used and calms down.
- **Long-term:** The penis is not more sensitive or responsive to pain or pleasure.

II. What about sexual intercourse?

If you feel a difference in sensitivity during penetration, ask your partner to contract the muscles around the vagina.

2

Your penis will be less sensitive at the beginning of the erection. Thus, you can delay ejaculation to prolong sexual intercourse.

Manual masturbation is facilitated because your partner will not hurt you by pulling too hard on the foreskin.

III. Protection against sexually transmitted diseases?

Adult **circumcision in Montreal** helps improve penis hygiene and helps prevent certain diseases such as:

- Penis cancer
- The balanite
- HIV contamination

This is due to the removal of a wetland (the foreskin), an environment that promotes the survival and reproduction of viruses.
